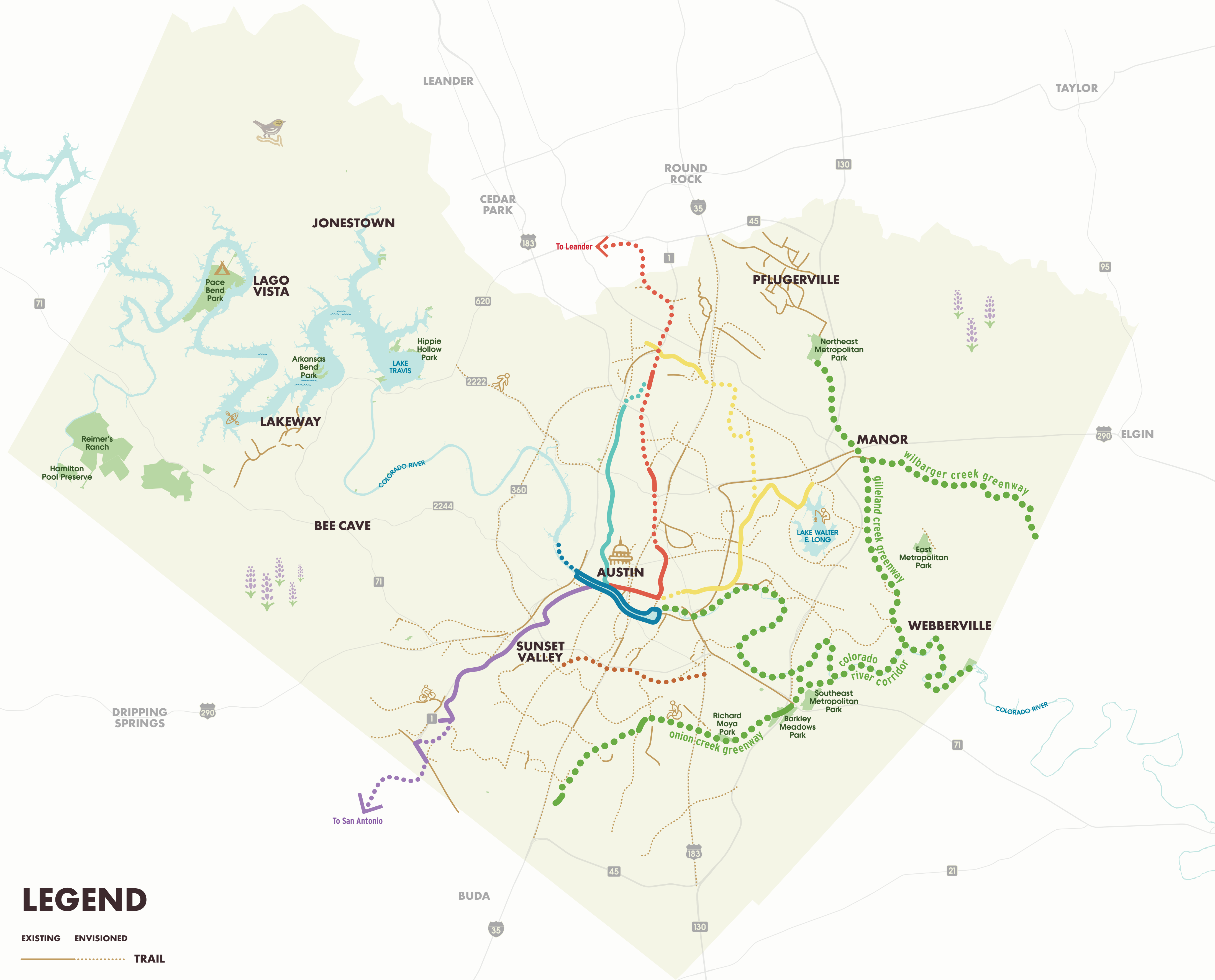


TRAVIS COUNTY GREENWAYS:

A Key Part of Our Growing Regional Trail System

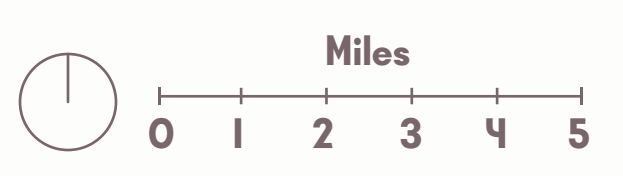


The envisioned Travis County Greenways are a critical piece of our regional trail network. These Greenways will create over seventy miles of connected trails along Onion, Wilbarger, and Gilleland Creeks and the Colorado River in eastern Travis County. This map shows our growing regional trail network, including envisioned and existing trails that are primarily off-street and greater than three miles in length.
