- Assist with the development and execution of monthly communication campaigns
- Manage TCPF's social media accounts (Instagram, Facebook, X, LinkedIn) and grow presence
- Create metrics and evaluate effectiveness
- Help update the TCPF website
- Research and develop ways to improve engagement and site traffic
- Assist with drafting the monthly e-newsletter
- Promote events, online store, volunteer opportunities, service days, and other events
- Assist with the development of marketing materials in partnership with design firm
- Draft media releases as appropriate
- Communicate frequently with TCPF's Executive Director
- Represent TCPF at public events
