It is our great joy to announce the second annual For the Love of Parks event at Richard Moya Park on Saturday, May 11, 2024 from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. Last year, we launched this event and were thrilled by the response we received from the community. In 2023, this celebration welcomed nearly 1,000 new and seasoned visitors to the park. The encouragement and support received solidified our desire to make it an annual celebration, and we want to personally invite you to be a part of the 2024 event. In the spirit of collaboration, community and celebration, this event will be free to the public and welcome everyone.

Our Travis County parks boast 11,000 acres with 27 parks ranging from metropolitan sports complexes to nationally recognized majestic natural preserves. While these parks primarily serve the people of Travis County, they are heavily used by residents of surrounding counties, and some attract state, national and even global visitors. We depend on these green spaces for a high quality of life, mental and physical health, economic strength, and environmental benefits.

This year, we invite you to join the Foundation in celebrating voter approval of \$276 million for Travis County parks as well as the launch of our three signature programs. In close partnership with parks staff, we are leading a collaborative initiative to create a 70-mile network of greenways in eastern Travis County that will connect to our growing regional trail system. In addition, the Foundation is spearheading the establishment of a robust astronomy and dark skies program at the Reimers Ranch Observatory and throughout the county. We also are launching a new Park Stewards Program to address key park needs through ongoing volunteer activities. These initiatives will bring park lovers together and create opportunities for engagement with our parks system in new and inspiring ways.
