Gallop to Gomorrah:

How Most Catholic Universities and Colleges Allow the Homosexual Movement to Subvert Moral Values




"Not to oppose error is to approve it; and not to defend truth is to suppress it; and indeed to neglect to confound evil men, when we can do it, is no less a sin than to encourage them." – Pope St. Felix III For several years, Tradition Family Property Student Action has documented the existence of pro-homosexual clubs and activities at Catholic universities and colleges in America. The present report brings previous TFP research up-to-date and serves to inform and alert fellow Catholics —especially students and parents— about the profound moral crisis shaking Catholic higher education.


Synopsis of Findings

Since 2012 the number of Catholic universities and colleges with pro-homosexual clubs and programs has risen from 111 to 130, representing a 9% growth. According to the U. S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, there are 218 Catholic universities and colleges in America (excluding seminaries and religious institutes).

Research shows that 59% of those 218 institutions have active pro-homosexual advocacy clubs and activities, which often promote the ideas of the Sexual Revolution and its ever-expanding Culture of Death. In short, instead of defending moral values, many Catholic centers of higher learning are allowing —and in some cases fostering and financing— the sinful gallop towards Gomorrah. This trend is a spiritual danger to souls.







Growth in Pro-Homosexual Clubs on Catholic College Campuses

2016 = 130 pro-homosexual clubs (No data was collected from 2013-2015) 2012 = 111 pro-homosexual clubs 2011 = 107 pro-homosexual clubs 2010 = 101 pro-homosexual clubs 2009 = 96 pro-homosexual clubs

Certain religious orders tend to favor pro-homosexual clubs, programs or activities at their institutions: For example, twenty-seven of the twenty-eight Jesuit-run institutions in the United States allow them. Among other religious orders, ten pro-homosexual clubs were found at academic institutions run by the Franciscan orders; nine by the Dominicans, eight by the Sisters of Mercy; six by the Congregation of the Holy Cross; four by the Sisters of St. Joseph; three by the Christian Brothers; three by the Marianists; and three by the Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet.

It should be noted that the data collected in this report was obtained simply from the information these universities have made available on their public web sites.

A detailed list of the 130 universities and colleges that recognize pro-homosexual clubs, together with the names of those clubs, are provided in this document, beginning on page eleven.

Why Pro-Homosexual Clubs Are a Problem

Lavender Graduations, queer film festivals, lewd gender-bending drag shows, campaigns against natural marriage, "coming out" celebrations, Day of Silence events, academic degrees in LGBT studies, pro-homosexual scholarships, and transgender bathrooms are some of the activities these clubs promote.

However, the Church teaches and has always taught unequivocally that homosexual behavior is intrinsically disordered.¹ As the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* states:

Basing itself on Sacred Scripture, which presents homosexual acts as acts of grave depravity, tradition has always declared that "homosexual acts are intrinsically disordered." They are contrary to the natural law. They close the sexual act to the gift of life. They do not proceed from a genuine affective and sexual complementarity. Under no circumstances can they be approved.²

Within Catholic institutions where virtue should reign, the homosexual movement is allowed to organize, recruit, and train new generations of activists set on subverting 2,000 years of Church teaching. At the same time, voices faithful to sound moral values are frequently hampered or silenced altogether, effectively opening a path for moral anarchy.

How Pro-Homosexual Clubs Subvert Morality: Three Examples

Example #1: John Carroll University

On October 10, 2015, John Carroll University (Jesuit) used student funds to host a sinful drag show and even paid so-called "drag queens" — men who act like women who perform the "gender bending"— to promote "a sense of awareness and pride held by the LGBTQ community." The only vocal opposition to this incident came from a single brave student, Devan Jacobson, who prayed while kneeling in the rain for three hours outside the building where the drag show took place.

"There's about four years of patient silence which is welling up within me, in which I have witnessed events taking place at John Carroll University which blatantly contravene infallibly defined Catholic teaching," Jacobson said. "But, I have remained prayerfully silent both in the hope that the University would come to its senses and return to its founding ideals, and

also as a consequence of having been intimidated into silence and on the margins of campus life by an academic environment which seems to nurture and extol every other fashionable current of thought, except Catholic orthodoxy..."

Although Jacobson's protest was peaceful and prayerful, some Jesuit priests who staff the university came out against him. According to *The Carroll News*, Fr. Jayme Stayer, S.J. accused Jacobson of being homophobic, naïve and uncharitable.³ The "welcoming" and "non-judgmental" attitudes in vogue only seem to favor sinful lifestyles, but do not extend to students like Jacobson who, faithful to their Baptismal vows, fight the forces of darkness and remain faithful to the Church.

Example #2: The University of Notre Dame

Officials at the University of Notre Dame, which has two pro-homosexual clubs on campus, hindered the formation of a student club that sought approval to promote a pro-marriage and pro-family message.

One such group was Students for Child Oriented Policy (SCOP). The group, which defended the idea that traditional marriage is best for children, was denied club status from the university on the grounds that it was too similar to already sanctioned clubs. But one of the groups that the university identified as being "too similar" had been inactive since 2005. According to University of Notre Dame law professor Gerard Bradley, the actual reason profamily students were denied club recognition was Notre Dame's "sheer hostility against what SCOP stands for."⁴

Example #3: The University of San Diego

Another cause of scandal is the University of San Diego, where annual drag shows explicitly "celebrate gender expression." Ignoring over 36,000 petitions of protest from Catholic students, alumni, and parents, the university hosted a recent drag show on April 14, 2016. USD is notorious for its on-campus pro-homosexual activists who support off-campus pro-homosexual advocacy groups via a "LGBTIQQ Resource Center."

One drag show at USD featured a performer dressed as Disney character Maleficent (the

only one to invoke "all the powers of hell")⁵ singing about how "good is evil" and "all evil is good." In response to this drag show, several students lead a rosary rally in protest. "The problem with what the school is doing is that it's essentially saying this lifestyle is not only acceptable, but that it's also morally OK," said Gerry Urbanek, a USD student. "I think that's creating a conflict and I think a lot of Catholics on campus are feeling defensive about that." However, the university brushed off these concerns and let the show go on because they "support dignity and equality."⁶

These three examples illustrate a deeper issue: On too many Catholic campuses, faithful Catholic students are increasingly not welcome to express what is true, holy and good. Their voices are muzzled and silenced in the very halls that extol the "marketplace of ideas" and the new secular dogma of "tolerance."

The Larger Culture War

When pastors and campus chaplains no longer preach clearly against the slavery of lust, the radical homosexual movement's biggest roadblock, Catholic truth, is neutralized or eliminated. Evil gains ground.

According to the Pew Research Center, support for homosexual "marriage" in America among Catholic millennials is significantly higher than the national average and slightly higher than the average for their age group with 75% in favor of homosexual "marriage."⁷

What are the factors behind the shift? Perhaps the most significant factor is a public relaxation or permissiveness on the part of high ranking and influential members of the clergy. A notable example is U.S. Cardinal Timothy Dolan's positive reaction to NFL player Michael Sam's "coming out" announcement⁸ or his tacit approval of the participation of

open homosexual groups in New York City's St. Patrick's Day Parade.⁹ Outside the U.S., statements by members of the European episcopacy such as Bishop Johann Bonny, Cardinal Reinhard Marx, Cardinal Christoph Schönborn, and Cardinal Walter Kasper have created an environment of ambiguity and confusion – or in some cases outright contradiction – regarding the moral teachings of the Church.¹⁰

It is also apparent that administrators and board members of many Catholic universities are engaging in a policy of politically correct appeasement towards the opinions of their student bodies and the godless culture at large. Another severe blow to morality was the U.S. Supreme Court's *Obergefell v. Hodges* decision, which granted legal recognition to counterfeit same-sex "marriage" in 2015.

Ultimately, the increase of pro-homosexual propaganda on Catholic campuses is largely due to a lack of leadership, vigilance and fidelity to the moral doctrine of the Catholic Church on the part of the respective university administrations and teaching staff. Catholic shepherds sadly leave open the doors to the wolves.

Catholic Campuses Challenge God: Transgender Restrooms and Housing

The homosexual movement is now moving to its next phase, demanding more special "rights." This phase emphasizes the transsexual "T" of the LGBT acronym. Commonly referred to as "Gender Theory," this latest effort aims to abolish male-female restrooms as well as do away with single sex housing arrangements.

The Cardinal Newman Society reports that the College of the Holy Cross, a Jesuit institution in Massachusetts, will be offering gender-inclusive housing in the 2016-2017 academic year. Likewise, the housing policy at the Catholic University of San Francisco contradicts basic biology and common sense by affirming that "human beings are not necessarily male or female as ascribed by their assigned gender at birth."¹¹

But as God's marvelous order for creation is contested, the implementation of "transgender" restrooms can only be expected to rise. So far, the following Catholic colleges and

universities have introduced transgender restrooms: Boston College, Creighton University, Fairfield University, Fordham University, Georgetown University, Marquette University, Santa Clara University, and the University of San Francisco – all Jesuit-run.¹²

Purity — the Missing Answer

The antidote to the Sexual Revolution —especially on Catholic campuses— is the angelic virtue, the forgotten virtue of purity. "To counter the homosexual offensive without also combating the sexual revolution is to disregard a most important part of this battle. Thus, we must struggle all the more against abortion, pornography and promiscuity. We must wage a spiritual crusade to bring chastity back to society and to restore modesty as the necessary guardian of purity and the expression of human dignity and honor."¹³

In order to truly regenerate our culture, there must be a robust response capable of defeating the slavery of sin; that is, a bold and unapologetic Crusade for purity. The more our culture sinks into the swamp of impurity, the more urgent this crusade of purity becomes, because the havoc of the Sexual Revolution is undeniably tearing our beloved nation apart:

- 40% to 50% of all marriages end in divorce.¹⁴
- 40% of all children are raised in homes without their fathers.¹⁵
- 40.2% of all children are born out of wedlock.¹⁶
- Half of all pregnancies in the U.S. are "unintended;" nearly 40% of these unborn children are aborted.¹⁷
- 48% of all new STD infections occur among the young.¹⁸

- 94% of HIV diagnoses among teenage boys and young adult males (ages 13 to 24) in 2011 were directly linked to homosexual activity.¹⁹
- 4.5 billion hours of porn were viewed worldwide in 2015, with the US representing the highest number of page views.²⁰
- 93% of boys and 62% of girls are exposed to internet pornography before the age of 18, according to Covenant Eyes.
- 69% of boys and 55% of girls have seen homosexual pornography, 39% and 23% respectively have seen sadomasochistic videos, 32% and 18% have viewed bestiality, 18% and 10% have seen real and simulated rape/sexual violence, and 15% and 9% have seen child pornography.²¹

The Ruth Institute –which seeks to combat the effects of the sexual revolution– has stated poignantly: "Cultural conservatives have allowed themselves to be out-maneuvered by the Sexual Revolutionaries. The Sexual Revolutionaries have defined the terms of the debate. They have largely dictated the cultural narrative about sex, marriage and family. Yet the full story of the harms of the Sexual Revolution has never been honestly and completely told... The Victims of the Sexual Revolution are largely invisible in society and voiceless in the cultural conversation."²²

Is it possible to remain silent? Don't Catholics have a moral obligation to proclaim the truth in season and out of season? Is it not imperative that Catholic universities and institutions do all they can to fight this onslaught, rather than succumb to it?

Call to Pray and Fight
