

Guide us with compassion, kindness and love that we might become fully human.







Nukes By the Numbers

- Nuclear weapons spending in 2021 White House Budget: \$48.7 billion.
- Change from 2020: +19%
- Change in diplomatic budget from 2020 to 2021: -22%
- Projected cost of building and maintaining the U.S. nuclear arsenal for the next 10 years: at least \$500 billion (CBO 2019 estimate adjusted for Trump administration 2021 budget increase).
- For the next 30 years: \$1.5 trillion
- Cost of 100,000 ICU-grade ventilators for COVID-19 treatment: \$5 billion
- Number of U.S. nuclear warheads: <u>Total</u>: 5,800 (1,750 deployed warheads, 2,050 stockpiled warheads (both active and inactive), plus 2,000 retired, intact warheads.) The U.S. and Russia possess approximately 90% of the world's estimated 13,000 nuclear warheads.

"Call to Action – VOICES Celebration of the TPNW Coming into Force" by Michael Ramos, Church Council of Greater Seattle, January 22, 2021:

Today, we celebrate the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons (TPNW) coming into force. Dedicated, wise, morally-committed, spiritually-grounded people like you have made this day possible. Civil society, public servants, elected officials, diplomats, organizations and peoples from all over - devoted to the elimination of nuclear weapons - have risen up as citizens and residents tied together with a global solidarity that says we belong to one precious, fragile, planet, or we cease to exist all together. TPNW suggests there is an alternative path to the proliferation and threat of nuclear weapons and mutually-assured destruction.

Now we take the next step to act, each in our local context. Like drops of water, each of which joins with the next to turn the mill, doing your part is crucial: to bringing more countries into the treaty, to no hair-trigger alert, to stopping first use, to defunding land-based nuclear missiles, to thwarting the modernization and expansion of nuclear weapons systems, to recognizing the humanity in one another regardless of state of origin and to say that All Lives Are Sacred!

Let our vigil inspire us and spread winds of a profound peace with justice. In our ongoing vigilance for life for our planet, let us:

- 1. Be awake, watch, listen, smell, feel, touch use all our senses to understand with compassion;
- 2. Speak the truth of what we know; honor the hibakusha, the Marshallese, the people of Vieques, the downwinders;
- 3. Overcome fear with love: our securities are bound up together; we are free from the threat of nuclear annihilation when we all are free;
- 4. Confront the idolatry of nuclear weapons; write a new story of cooperation rooted in civil society and reverencing the integrity of creation;
- 5. Act boldly with spirit, like our lives depend on it;
- 6. Be people of peace; see the intersection of systems of oppression and use our power for their transformation;
- 7. Light candles together; embrace community;
- 8. Trust that repair of the world is possible and is well under way.

We vigil for the next 7 generations, and the 7 after that. We choose life so that we and our descendants may live. We, who have the capacity to be moved, also have the audacity to act. We are charged to use our civil power to challenge authorities and policies that place faith in nuclear weapons and to build a bridge across borders that honors human flourishing here and there - friend and foe alike - toward a common global future where nuclear weapons are abolished, indeed the only future possible.

"If not us, then who? If not here, then where? If not now, then when?" The global circle of solidarity is larger than when we began. Let us make the circle ever wider, until the promise of a world without nuclear weapons is realized.



1. Invitation to Endorse: Open Letter to Presidents Putin and Biden in advance of their June 16, 2021 Summit

[Please do not circulate publicly until released on June 10]

We write to you, world leaders whom we know fully understand the catastrophic humanitarian consequences of any use of nuclear weapons, and the cataclysmic effects on humanity of a nuclear war: the possible end of civilization as we know it.

We are participants of a growing international campaign for a commitment by nuclear-armed states to a policy of no first use of nuclear weapons. We have just completed a number of successful global events, including a two-day conference preparatory to launching this campaign, which have included over 700 participants from Asia, Africa, Europe, Middle East, South America, North America, and the Pacific. Arising from these events is an appeal to you to use your summit to make a mutual bilateral commitment on No First Use (NFU) as a first step to adoption of such a commitment by other nuclear weapon states and to the elimination of all nuclear weapons.

We are mindful that decades ago your predecessors declared "A nuclear war cannot be won and must never be fought". A few years ago, Mr. Biden, you declared in an eloquent speech about the threat of nuclear war, "If we want a world free of nuclear weapons, the United States must take the initiative to lead us there." Similarly, Mr. Putin, you have said "The understanding that a third world war could be the end of civilization should restrain us from taking extreme steps on the international arena that are highly dangerous for modern civilization." The United Nations set the goal to eliminate nuclear weapons in its very first resolution which was adopted unanimously, and reaffirmed this in 2013 by establishing September 26th as the annual International Day for the Total Elimination of Nuclear Weapons.

Now is the perfect time for you to declare a joint commitment that your nations will not use nuclear weapons first under any circumstances, and to make this a key step toward fulfilling the UN goal to totally eliminate nuclear weapons from the planet. We pledge to you - as legislators, former political/military leaders and representatives of multiple civil movements endorsing this goal - to mobilize civil and political support for your effort.

You should know that such a measure will be supported by most of the other 189 States Parties of the Non-Proliferation Treaty who unanimously agreed in 2010 to support 'policies that could prevent the use of nuclear weapons' and 'to establish the necessary framework to achieve and maintain a world without nuclear weapons', and will be strongly supported by the 122 nations that in 2017 approved the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons.

We believe it is in your hearts to achieve this noble goal. We call on you to initiate this vital step at your summit and to lead us all to a planet free of nuclear weapons.
