Executive Summary

- As of November 28, 2022, survey submissions increased by 176 from the previous week, making the total submissions 10,145. 3,956 homeowners were determined to be in Phases I – VI.
- 3,432 environmental reviews have been completed, representing 87% of the 3,956 homeowners in Phases I – VI.
- 2,983 homeowners have been invited to complete applications from Phase I - VI. 1,793 applications have been completed, representing 60% of the homeowners invited to complete an application.
- There has been a total of 601 grant awards offered to homeowner. Of those, 94 homeowners have closed on their grant agreements, obligating \$7,939,205.68 .

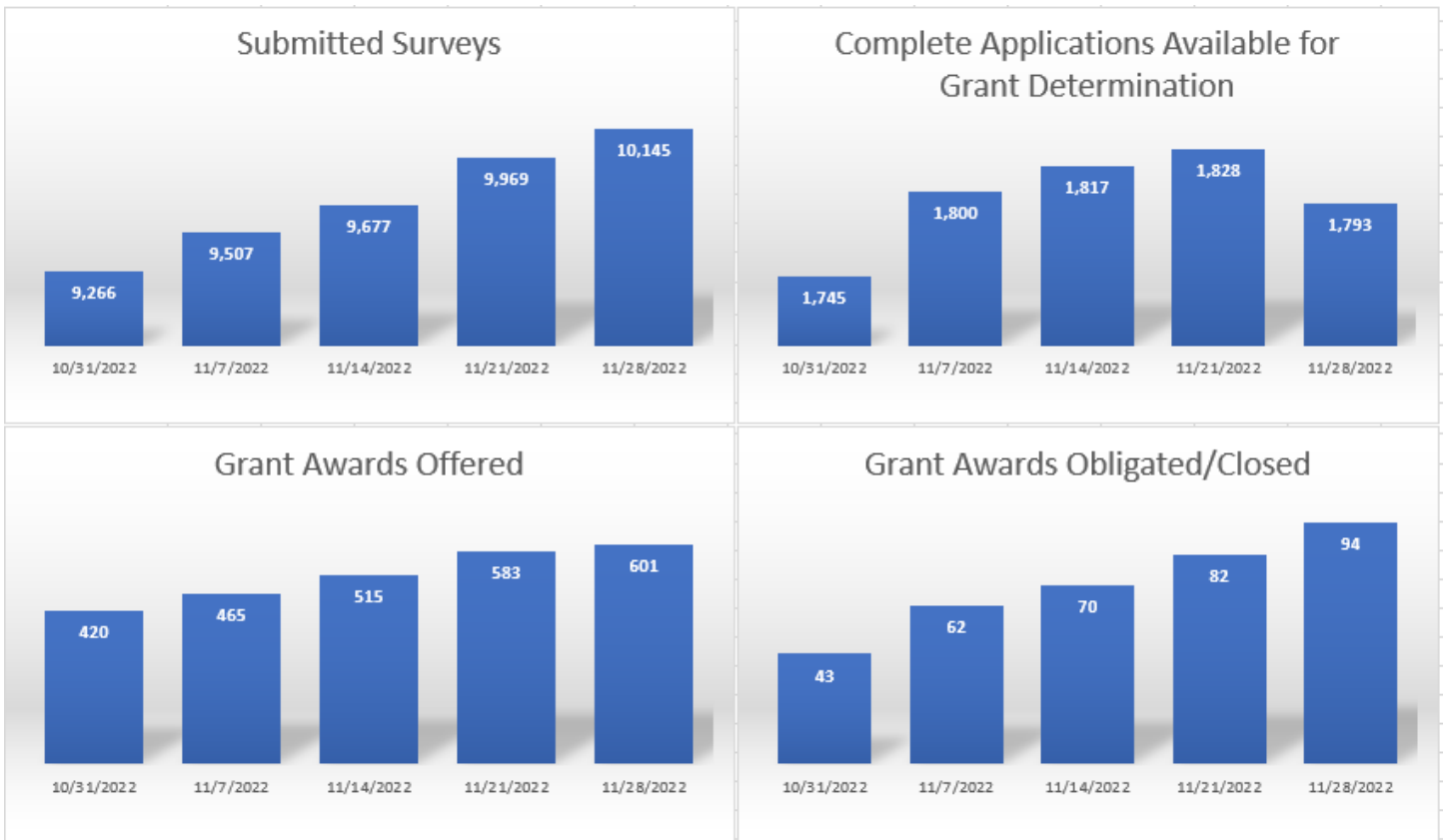
