Apply today for the **Restore Louisiana Small Business Loan Program**

The **Restore Louisiana Small Business Loan Program** provides loan assistance for non-construction expenses to eligible small businesses and nonprofits that were affected by 2020-21 disaster events through participating non-profit lenders.

Scan the QR code or visit restore.la.gov/SBLP to get started on your application today.

To qualify for a loan, businesses must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ 1-50 full-time employees (35 hours or more per week)
- ✓ Open and in operation at the time of the disaster event
- ✓ Minimum \$25,000 in annual gross revenues before the disaster event
- ✓ Located in one of the parishes eligible for program participation
- ✓ Experienced either a financial or physical loss as a result of one of the 2020-21 disaster events – Hurricanes Laura, Delta or Ida or the May 2021 Severe Storms
- ✓ Have an eligible unmet need after accounting for duplication of benefits

Loans will be 0% interest, partially forgivable, and 60% repayable, subject to the terms of the loan.

Total awards will range from
\$10,000 minimum to \$150,000 maximum.

How do I get started?

Interested small businesses should scan the QR code or visit restore.la.gov/SBLP to identify the lender servicing their area and complete an application. Your lender will work with you through the qualification process.
