



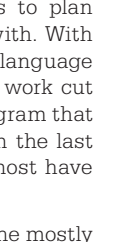

When we convene with our friends at OLLAS every two years to plan Cinemateca, we never really know what we're going to come up with. With so many exciting things happening in Spanish- and Portuguese-language cinema, and such a rich film tradition to draw upon, we have our work cut out for us. For our fourth biennial Cinemateca, we decided on a program that is unique from our previous series in that all of the films are from the last several years, a sure sign of a brilliant and thriving scene, and most have documentary elements.

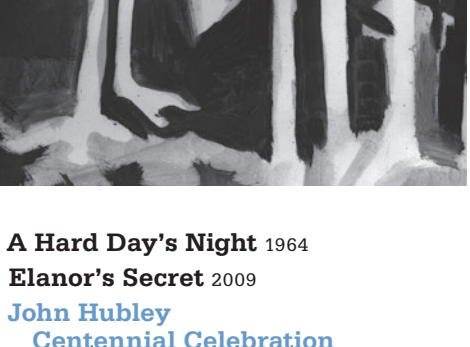
The program includes two first-run films playing for a week each: the mostly fictional Mexican-American story **STAND CLEAR OF THE CLOSING DOORS** and the deeply personal Brazilian film essay **ELENA**. Two of the documentaries selected for the series, **LA CAMIONETA** and the Spanish film **KEEP ON ROLLING**, will be accompanied by filmmaker visits. Next, we'll have the Argentinian music doc **MERCEDES SOSA: THE VOICE OF LATIN AMERICA** for one night only. We and our fantastic partners at OLLAS are proud to once again present great art that transcends borders.

We have an iconic summer planned for film lovers of all ages. Our Summer Forever Young series begins with a British invasion on the Fourth of July. It's the fiftieth anniversary restoration of the film that captures The Beatles as they became the biggest band of all time, **A HARD DAY'S NIGHT!** Next, it's **ELEANOR'S SECRET**, an animated journey through some of the great works of children's literature. Then, we'll celebrate the centennial year of animator John Hubley with a program of his most innovative work. After working on Disney classics like **FANTASIA** and **PINNOCHIO** and creating characters like Mr. Magoo, Hubley began making more personal cartoons that verged on the magical. The series will continue with a revival of that all-time tale of kids outsmarting adults, **THE PARENT TRAP**. Then, we'll wrap up the summer with **ANINA**, a kid-friendly Cinemateca offering, and **NOCTURNA**, a Spanish-French animated film.

Location, Hours & Parking

Film Streams' Ruth Sokolof Theater is located at 1340 Mike Fahey Street in downtown Omaha, within the Saddle Creek Records complex—one block west of the TD Ameritrade ballpark and one block south of Cuming Street. Showtimes begin in the early evening Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, and early afternoon Thursday, Saturday, Sunday.

Free parking is available in the lot behind our theater, accessible from 14th Street between Cuming and Mike Fahey Streets. Street parking is also available in the vicinity surrounding the cinema (free after 5pm weekdays and all day on weekends).

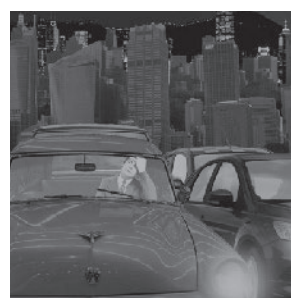
