After three months of great film in our theaters, we quickly pivoted to virtual cinema, partnering with distributors to bring new releases and repertory film to our audiences. In August 2020, in partnership with the Salt Lake Film Society, we launched Film Streams @Home – our own virtual streaming platform.

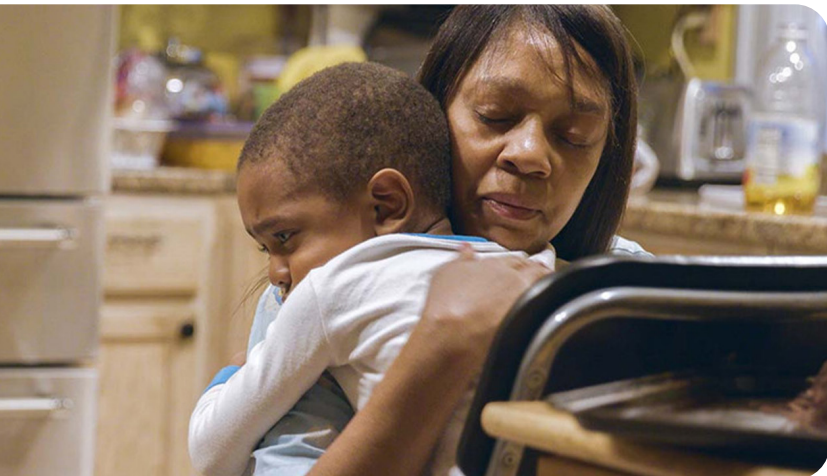

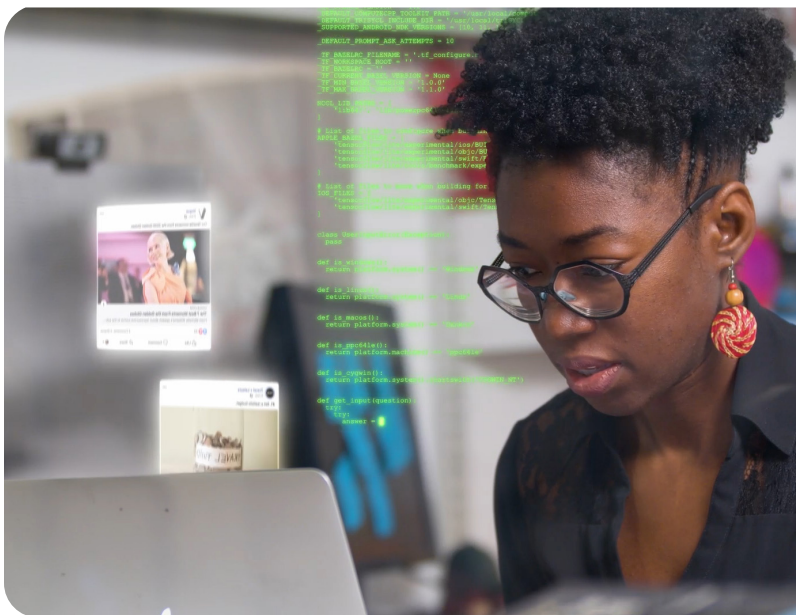

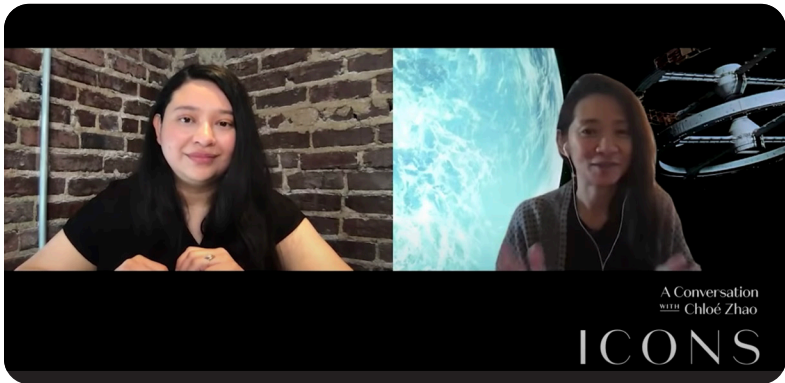
