We want to be a zero-waste company

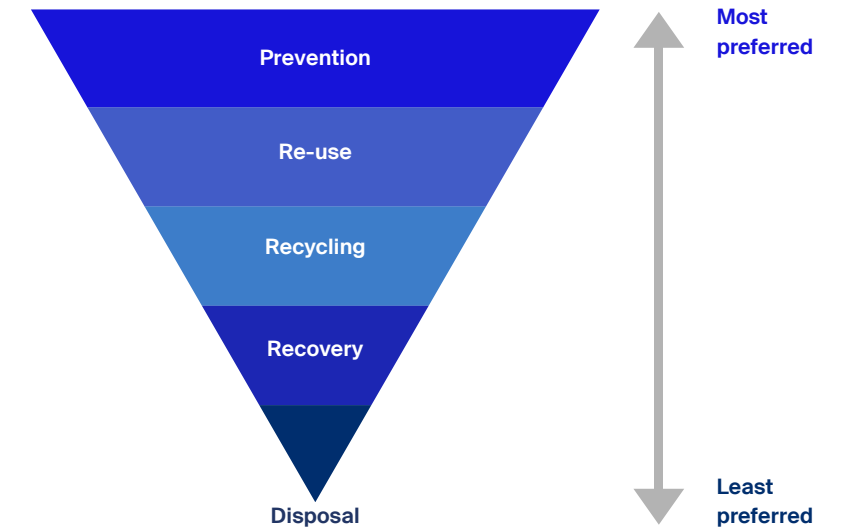


- We are striving to become a zero-waste company and we aim to be a driver for a circular economy, conserve resources, and minimize our environmental impact to the environment.

What

We implement good waste management practices across the entire organization



- **Minimize Waste Generation:** we strive to prevent waste generation at its source through efficient production processes, responsible procurement, and the promotion of waste reduction practices among employees and stakeholders. Where recycling or reuse is not possible, we ensure that waste is disposed in compliance with all relevant regulations.
- **Waste Segregation:** we implement a comprehensive waste segregation system at all our facilities with clearly labeled waste bins to ensure proper separation of different waste streams.
- **Recycling and Reuse:** we recycle and reuse materials wherever feasible. This includes partnering with certified recycling vendors to process recyclable materials and exploring opportunities for internal reuse or repurposing of waste materials.
- **Monitoring and Reporting:** we systematically track and monitor waste generation, recycling rates, and disposal methods. Regular reports assess our progress, identify areas for improvement, and ensure communication to all stakeholders through the sustainability report.
- **Hazardous Waste Management:** we identify and manage hazardous waste in accordance with applicable regulations regarding storage, handling, and disposal.
