What's a fanzine?

A non-official publication created by a group of enthusiasts. Fanzines were hugely popular in the pre-internet punk years of the 1970s due to being so easy and cheap to produce.

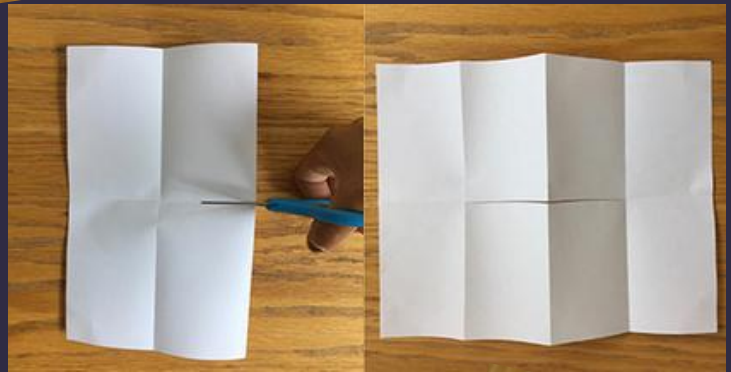
STEP 1

Fold your sheet of paper in half. Fold it again into quarters, and then one more time so it's folded into eighths.



STEP 2

Open your paper so that it's folded in half. Cut halfway across the middle from the fold. When you open your paper it should have a slit in the middle.



STEP 3

Fold your paper lengthwise (along the crease that has the slit). Hold the paper at either end, then push the ends in toward each other. The sections should fold into each other to form an eight-page booklet.



STEP 4

GET CREATIVE

Split into groups and decorate your zines!
