

Job title: Lead ERP Developer

Function: To design, develop and maintain customisations and integrations for the Acumatica ERP platform, ensuring seamless connectivity with other business systems and alignment with organisational processes. The role will focus on leveraging modern development practices and technologies while learning Acumatica's framework

Hours of work: 40 hours a week Monday-Friday

Duties:

- Develop and maintain custom screens, fields, and workflows within Acumatica using its customisation tools.
- Design and implement integrations between Acumatica and external systems (CRM, WMS, BI tools, e-commerce platforms, etc.) using REST/SOAP APIs and middleware.
- Create and optimise Generic Inquiries, reports, and dashboards for data exchange and analytics.
- Collaborate with business analysts and stakeholders to translate requirements into technical solutions.
- Ensure code quality, maintainability, and adherence to best practices.
- Support upgrades and troubleshoot issues related to customisations and integrations.
- Document technical designs and maintain version control

Qualifications and Skills:

- Strong analytical and problem-solving skills.
- Ability to understand business processes and translate them into technical solutions.
- Excellent communication and collaboration skills.

- Experience with SDLC, version control (Git), and agile methodologies.
- C# and .NET Framework/Core – Acumatica customisations are built on .NET.
- ASP.NET & Web Development – Acumatica uses web-based UI.
- SQL & Database Design – Acumatica runs on SQL Server; strong T-SQL skills are essential.
- REST & SOAP APIs – For integrations with external systems.
- JavaScript & HTML/CSS – For UI enhancements.
- JSON & XML – Common in data exchange and API payloads.
- Understanding of ORM (PX.Data) – Acumatica uses its own ORM layer similar to Entity Framework.
- Basic Cloud Concepts – Acumatica SaaS runs on Azure; familiarity with cloud environments is helpful.
- Integration Middleware (e.g., Boomi, Celigo, or similar) – desirable but not mandatory
- Desirable: Experience with ERP systems (any platform).
- Desirable: Familiarity with reporting tools (e.g., Power BI, Qlik).
- Desirable: Knowledge of business domains like finance, inventory, or supply chain.

Personal Attributes:

- Strong ability to lead and influence stakeholders
- Resilient and adaptable to change
- Strong sense of ownership and accountability
